Dear Dr Sachs,

I write in relation to your e-mail of 12 January 2022, registered under Ares(2022)210656, and other subsequent e-mails on the same issue in October and November 2022.

In your correspondences, you repeat your grievances against the refusal by Belgian authorities to authorise your access to the Belgian national health insurance system. You consider that EU law was breached in your case and that this refusal is due to corruption in Belgium. You name some politicians that you consider involved in this alleged corruption.

We replied to your letters of 12 January by a letter of 3<sup>rd</sup> February registered under reference Ares(2022)812463. We confirm our analysis and conclusion in a letter sent to you on 9 November (Ares(2022)7726520) replying to your letters of 12, 14 and 26 October as well as 4 November. You sent again a series of letters, expressing similar grievance, on 10 November 2022.

I regret to inform you that we do not have anything to add to our previous correspondence. Please note that the Commission reserves the right to discontinue repetitive correspondence.
