Exact words of the EU Court:

"A Member State cannot, under its national legislation, refuse to affiliate to its public sickness insurance scheme a [European] Union citizen.

"The Court confirms the right of economically inactive Union citizens residing in a Member State other than their Member State of origin to be affiliated to the public sickness insurance system of the host Member State in order to obtain medical care financed by that State.

"The Court notes that Member States, are under an obligation to comply with the provisions of EU law ... they cannot determine to what extent their own legislation or that of another Member State is applicable."

Court of Justice confirms economically inactive EU citizens have right to be affiliated to health insurance system of another Member State

Economically inactive Union citizens residing in a Member State other than the one from which they originate are entitled to be affiliated to the public health insurance system of the host Member State, the European Court of Justice confirmed, sitting as a Grand Chamber, in a judgment (Case C-535/19) delivered on Thursday 15 July. However, it states that the host State may provide that such membership is not free of charge in order to avoid the persons concerned becoming an unreasonable...
